

- I. When applying for Department of Educational Psychology scholarships, please make sure that you thoroughly understand the guidelines and deadlines for each one. Be aware that some scholarships are available only to certain groups such as Counseling and Counseling Psychology and School Psychology students. If you do not meet the criteria for a certain scholarship, your application will not be considered. A complete list of all scholarships and guidelines is available on the Department's website: www.ed.utah.edu/edps/. All scholarship recipients must be U.S. citizens, permanent residents, or have a valid student visa. All scholarship funding depends on available funds, which vary from year to year.
- II. If applying for more than one scholarship, you must submit a separate and complete application for each one. Please note that materials in your department admission files will not be available for scholarship applications. It is your responsibility to make sure that each scholarship application you submit is complete *--incomplete applications will not be considered*. Once submitted, all application materials become the property of the Department of Educational Psychology and will not be returned. Applications are evaluated by Department of Educational Psychology faculty and staff.
- III. In addition to the information requested on this application, please attach the following:
 - 1. In no more than 3, double-spaced pages, please write a statement in which you describe why you are a qualified candidate for the scholarship; academic accomplishments and professional goals; and your community service and involvement.
 - 2. A list of 3 references, including one person who is able to speak to your academic competencies.
 - 3. At least one official transcript (can be photocopied for multiple applications).
- IV. Your completed application must include a signed application form, official transcript, and any additional supporting documentation requested (e.g. personal statement). Submit each application in a large, unsealed envelope with your name and the name of the scholarship written on the outside.
